## INFORMATION

- At this time, the Visitor Center, US Post Office General Store, School, Methodist Church and Life Saving Station are open to the public. Some structures are occupied by NPS personnel or NPS lease holders. Please respect their privacy.
- There are excellent shelling possibilities along the beach.
- Fishing can be done all along the beach and inlet area.
- Camping is permitted only along the beach outside of the Historic District.
- Bird watching is possible anywhere on the island.
- Ask your Captain where to clam.
- The Beach is a 1.5 mile walk from the Village over a sand flat. The beach is secluded and beautiful.
- You may be dropped off at either the dock or the beach (weather permitting).
- Strong currents and rip tides are often common along the beach.
